NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that East Sussex County Council proposes to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers which will introduce a prohibition of driving and no waiting at any time restrictions in the following lengths of road:

Prohibition of driving in the following road in St Leonards-on-Sea:

Junction Road - from its junction with The Ridge West southwards for 101.3 metres.

No waiting at any time in the following roads in St Leonards-on-Sea:

Whitworth Road - Northern side - From the eastern Queensway Gateway Road roundabout eastwards for 178.4 metres.

Whitworth Road - Northern side - Westwards from the junction with A21 Sedlescombe Road North for 51.4 metres.

Whitworth Road - Southern side - From the eastern Queensway Gateway Road roundabout eastwards for 418.8 metres.
