Recent progress

Seaside Road site clearance has been completed, including the decommission of the existing traffic signals, pedestrian crossing, illuminated signage and street lighting columns. The team have also begun removing existing kerbs ahead of one lane reopening on Monday.

Terminus Road has seen more materials being laid, including concrete, binder materials and asphalt.

What's happening next week

Work will continue on Seaside Road with the team removing kerbstones on each of the four corners of the junction with Terminus Road. This is in preparation for new kerbing to be installed in the future.

In Terminus Road, pavers will begin to be laid in the footway and carriageway. Access to shop fronts will not be affected during this time.

Traffic management in place and coming up

From Monday 16 June, Seaside Road will be opened to through traffic with a one-lane closure in place.
