

Station Approach Construction Update

Devonshire Road, Havelock Road, Cornwallis Terrace

28 August 2026

Recent progress

Overnight closures have been in place this week including tonight. During the overnight works, we resurfaced the crossroads and into Devonshire Road. This involved removing the existing surface and replacing it with a new, smoother surface, as well as reinstating the High Friction Surfacing (HFS) and road markings.

Paving works have also continued on the corner of Havelock Road and Cornwallis Terrace. Tactile paving has also been installed for the crossing points either side of Station Approach, NAL sockets have also been installed ready for the crossing signal posts.

New street lighting has also been installed on Cornwallis Terrace.

What's happening next week

Paving works will continue on the corner of Havelock Road and Cornwallis Terrace. The pedestrian walkway will be moved onto the completed section, allowing work to begin on the remaining half.

Paving installation will also continue on both sides of Station Approach, along with the installation of further NAL sockets for the crossing signal posts.

Traffic management in place and coming up

Temporary traffic signals are in place 24-hours a day until 11 September.

Pedestrians should remain on the pavements and use the temporary crossings to follow the route around the site while works are underway.
