

Denton Corner Construction Update

Mount Road, Avis Road, Seaford Road

11 September 2026

Recent progress

Excavation works are currently being undertaken between the roundabout and Mount Road to form the new road entrance from the roundabout into the bus interchange.

On the southern side of the A259 Seaford Road, excavation work has been carried out to create a new cycle lane. This has included removing existing kerbs, clearing vegetation and excavating the existing verges. Following completion of this work, edging kerbs were installed, and sub-base preparation is ongoing.

What's happening next week

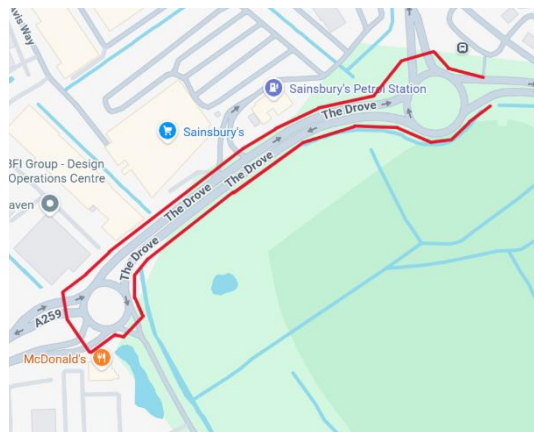
Excavation work will continue for the new bus interchange entrance, followed by the installation of new drainage in this area. Sub-base preparation will also continue for the new cycle lane on Seaford Road, alongside the installation of new kerbs.

Excavation works will also begin on Avis Road, just north of the Mount Road junction, to enable construction of the new footway and crossing point in this area.

Traffic management in place and coming up

A reduced speed limit is currently in place on the A259 Seaford Road to help keep site staff safe.

The pedestrian crossing on the A259 Seaford Road is also temporarily closed while work continues in the area, with the diversion route via the crossings on Drove Road and McKinlay Way. This closure will remain in place for the duration of the project.
